As a parent/guardian and performer, we understand that:

- 1. I must purchase tickets in order to participate in the event.
- 2. The Academy relies on volunteers to manage and perform the numerous tasks before, during and after this mainstage performance, of which I may be asked to help.
- 3. Rehearsals will be conducted during regular class time within the months leading up to the performance. Additional rehearsals may be required.
- 4. If my child is casted in a supporting or lead role, he or she must participate in the educational performances on March 11th and 12th.

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- 5. Rehearsals are **mandatory** and cannot be missed. Students will be informed of their rehearsal day and time at the venue.
- 6. If a student misses more than 3 rehearsals, he/she will be removed from the performances.
- 7. Leotards, tights, and proper dance shoes (appropriate warm-ups optional) must be worn to all rehearsals outside of class.
- 8. For rehearsals outside of class:
 - There are no food breaks during rehearsals! Please make provision to eat before or after rehearsals.
 - Promptness is of the utmost importance, please call if you will be **late** or **absent**.
 - There is no leaving the premises during rehearsals.
 - Each performer is responsible for keeping track of their rehearsal schedule always check bulletin board as schedules can change frequently.
- 9. The Academy has the right to refuse my child from participating in the mainstage performance due to repeated disregard or negligence of payment and studio policies, disruptive behavior, or any other reason that would put the studio, its staff or other students in jeopardy.
- 10. Strenuous physical activity, such as exerted in Covenant Ballet Academy related activities, has a proclivity to injury. Thus, the students agree to warm-up properly and to be mentally and emotionally prepared for each rehearsal and performance, and agrees not to hold Covenant Ballet Theatre of Brooklyn responsible for any injury sustained during his/her term with Covenant Ballet Academy.

Covenant Ballet Theatre of Brooklyn shall have the right to use the name and photograph and to exhibit the same through any medium whatsoever and at any time in the future for advertising, promotional, or commercial purposes.
